## \*DRESS CODE REMINDERS\*

Skirts/Shorts/Slacks/Skorts:

- Solid color: Khaki
- Style must be cotton twill blend(no jean style or material)

Hose/Tights:

- Solid color: White, navy blue or skin tone

Socks:

- Solid color: White, navy blue or khaki
- Mandatory wear
- Designs, emblems, insignias and logos are prohibited

Pullovers of Any kind:

- Solid color: Navy blue or white
- Pullover V-neck or pullover crew(hoods are prohibited)
- Turtlenecks are prohibited
